We will take a short break from our normal ELA routine to learn about Pilgrims and Thanksgiving. Students will utilize writing, reading, and vocabulary skills.

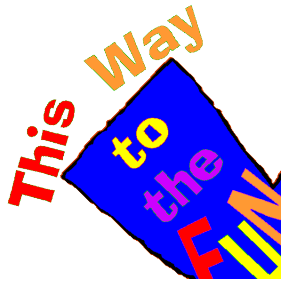
