Math ~ This week:

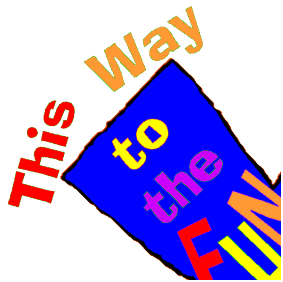
Students are continuing chapter 2.
